

LTVCA, UTRCA, and SCRCA work together as the Thames-Sydenham and Region Source Protection Region with provincial funding to protect municipal drinking water sources




■ Emerald Ash Borer infestation results in the destruction of 90,000 trees to prevent the spread

Carey Carolinian Continuation of Chatham-Kent Arboretum and Trail officially **Greening Strategy** started in 2007 that opens at Longwoods Road




