- 28 municipalities meet in Thamesville and vote to create the LTVCA for the purpose of flood control and flood warning November 10, 1960

**LTVCA forms on February 2, 1961**

- With less than 10% tree cover, trees are planted to help stop erosion in the Lower Thames watershed

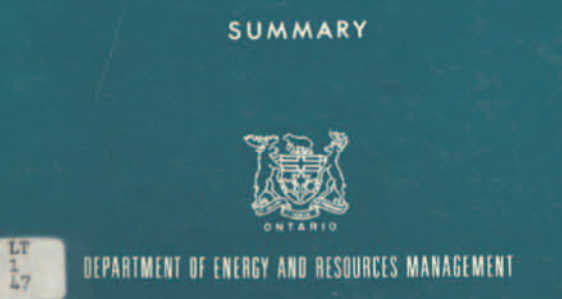


- The Administration Building is located at 41 4th Street, Chatham

**LOWER THAMES VALLEY CONSERVATION REPORT 1966**

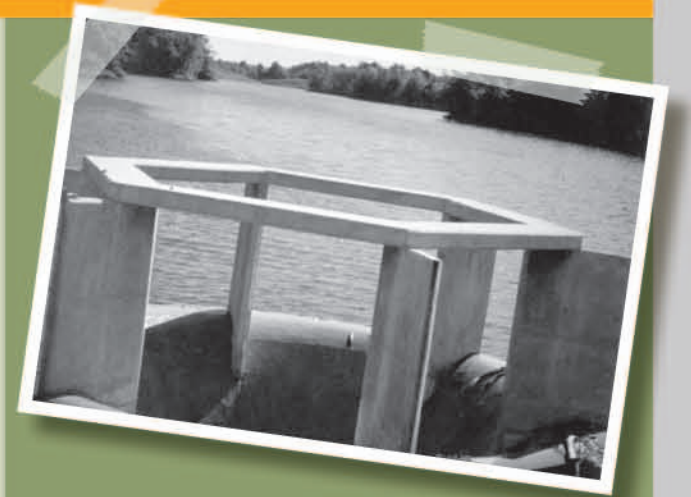


- Dover Township is included in the LTVCA



- The MacLaren Report directs flood control downstream from Chatham
- Dyke and erosion control work begins
- 401-Harwich Conservation Area (known today as C.M. Wilson Conservation Area) is purchased

- The Paincourt Creek drainage system is included in the Conservation Authority
- A 3,000 year old archaeological site is found at Big Bend Conservation Area
- Indian/McGregor Creek Flood Control Project is proposed



- A ceremony marks completion of Sharon Creek dam and spillway
- Sharon Creek and Big Bend Conservation Areas are stocked with trout



- Right to vote is extended to First Nations peoples unconditionally
- Nixon Kennedy television debates
- Halogen lamp invented

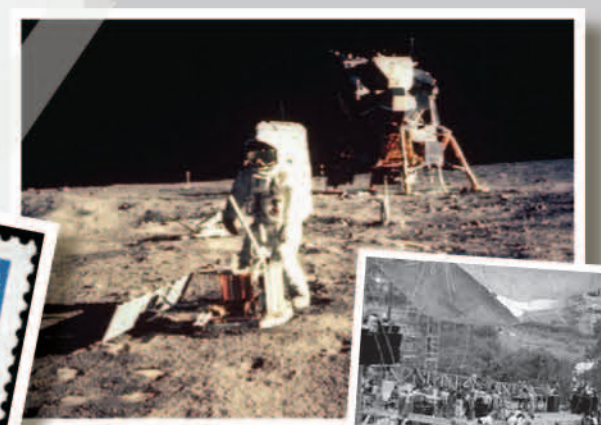
