

If You Want to Plant Trees Yourself, You Can!

You're thinking of buying trees from us but want to keep project costs down. One way to do that is to rent one of our tree planters. We charge \$85.00 per day (plus HST) and require you to pick up and return the planter to our site.

A day's rental with the right crew of four to five people (one tractor driver, two planter operators, and one or two supplying the planter with trees and checking to make sure the trees' roots are covered) can expect to get 3000 trees planted in a day; enough to plant roughly five acres. Planters attached by three-point hitch and standard pioneer tips for hydraulic lines. Refer to photos for tractor requirements.

This is a popular option with landowners/project managers as it allows for them to get more involved with their conservation project and is a good way to make some memories with family, friends, volunteers, or community groups.
