SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To assist in creating a traveling display to celebrate and promote the activities of Ska-Nah-Doht Village and Museum and the Longwoods Road Conservation Area and feature the First Nations approach to the environment and teachings for conservation issues of today.
2. To contact local organizations and schedule the traveling display at events in the community.
3. Supervise Conservation Outreach Assistant when working off-site.
4. While not traveling, create activities for visitors in order to educate and increase their knowledge of local heritage and environmental issues.
5. Assist with the everyday activities of a rural museum including interacting with the public, opening and closing the buildings, gift shop duties and admissions.
6. Perform other duties as assigned.
