

REFORESTATION & NATIVE TALL GRASS

Project Agreement to Acquire Funds

- 1. Site preparation is the landowner's responsibility which includes:
 - a. Mowing weeds, grass
 - b. Spraying grasses/ weeds if needed
 - c. Potentially planting a cover crop. Site must be lightly tilled. LTVCA can assist with seeding or planting.
- 2. <u>Site maintenance is the landowner's responsibility</u>, the first three years after planting are the most important for best survival, growth rate, and establishment. Maintenance includes:
 - a. Tree Planting
 - i. Mowing and maintaining a grass free zone around the stem (approximately 1' or 30cm diameter) via herbicide or mulch.
 - b. Native Tall Grass
 - i. Mowing once in mid-June or when the Canada Thistle flowers, again in late October.
- 3. Landowner is responsible for the retention of the project for a minimum of 15 years.

Survival assessments on tree planting projects will be done the year of planting, year 2 and year 5.

4. Full payment is required up front for Tree Planting orders and Native Tall Grass planting to ensure order confirmation and funding securement.

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Incentive Information

Forest Ontario 50 MTP: minimum 2.5 acres, up to 75% coverage, landowner pays a minimum 25% of cost, windbreaks are covered but maybe only eligible for 50% coverage, area cannot have been designated a woodlot in 10 years, does not cover shrubs, Blue Spruce and Austrian Pine.

OPG funding (Chatham-Kent only): minimum 1 acre, 40% coverage, landowner pays 60% of total cost, windbreaks are not eligible.

Forest Ontario Forest Recovery Program: minimum 1.5 acres or 1000 trees, up to 75% coverage, landowner pays a minimum of 25% of cost, site may have been designated woodlot, 10% shrub component allowed. Will fund Colorado Blue Spruce and Austrian Pine.

Wetland Restoration: Incentives for wetland restoration of 50% or more are offered through LTVCA and partnering organizations, please contact staff for more details.

Native Tall Grass: LTVCA offers incentives on agricultural buffer strips and prairie restoration of 50% or more; please contact stewardship staff for more details.
